

Wellbeing and Safety Policy for Young People

- 1. The wellbeing and safety of young people is paramount for Españolé Ih Valencia
- 2. We strive to make Españolé Ih Valencia a welcoming and safe environment where all clients feel happy, safe and secure at all times. We comply with the laws of this country.
- 3. The safety and security of the building is important. We ensure that we have the right safety equipment, and emergency evacuation and first aid procedures.
- 4. When we recruit new members of staff, we are careful that they have no prior history that would make them unsuitable to work with young people under the age of 18.
- 5. All members of staff at Españolé Ih Valencia are trained to look after the wellbeing of young people.
- 6. It is totally unacceptable for any member of staff at Españolé Ih Valencia to have any inappropriate relationships with any clients, particularly under the age of 18. This would result in termination of their contract.
- 7. The managers of Españolé Ih Valencia are available to speak to parents regarding any matters concerning their children. Contact the administration team at any time to arrange a meeting.

- 9. If anybody at Españolé Ih Valencia thinks that any young person is being hurt (by anybody inside or outside the school) we will act upon this information and follow the correct legal procedure. We will not ignore it.
- 10. We will ask parent's permission if we take their children on a trip or outside the school premises. This will include where and when they are going.
